GROUPSPACE HEALTH

Ventilation

Ventilation is on continually to ensure fresh air inside the space. The ventilation unit is moderated by a CO2 sensor located on the control panel. There is no need to make adjustments as the ventilation system is completely automatic. Up to 99.9% of harmful particles are removed from the air entering the space. Air cleaning occurs in two stages of filtration. The prefilter (located on the roof at the air intake opening) should be changed every 3 – 4 months while the HEPA filter (located within the space underneath the grill at air entry) should be changed every 12 – 24 months. Scheduling can be arranged by your sales contact.

Trip switch

A trip switch is located below the control panel that may engage if there is a power surge, device overload or other accidental cause. In this case, do not flick the switch back on until the faulty device has been unplugged from the socket. If you are unsure, consult a professional. The space should always be connected to a 230v/10A socket.

Lighting

The space is equipped with Photon Disinfection lighting which is completely service free. The light changes from blue (WiSDOM AiR) to white (ANTiBAC) due to a motion sensor depending on occupancy. You can turn the blue light on or off manually by a quick flick of the light switch marked 0/1. You can turn the white light on or off by flicking the switch marked with the ramp image. You can control the brightness of this light keeping this switch pressed down. The blue light is completely safe for humans and materials. The light is non-ionizing, and this has been tested by Radiation and Nuclear Safety Authority of Finland. (STUK 2017)

Optional equipment

A USB charging socket comes equipped with a 5V/1A power source.

TV connectivity includes a HDMI and USB connection to the television. They are found under the small covers on the control panel.

Cooling works by remote control. Choose your desired temperature and let automation take care of the rest.

Cleaning

Follow these recommendations when cleaning your Groupspace, or hand them over to the person responsible for cleaning. It is recommended to use as neutral cleaning agents as possible. Neutral cleaning agents are always preferred to using powerful shock treatment with strong cleaning agents that can be abrasive to surfaces. If you have to use exceptionally strong cleaning agents, test on a small area that is preferably out of view first, so you know if the agent is suitable for the surface you are cleaning.

Glass surfaces

Use window cleaning spray or diluted washing up liquid. Wipe sown lightly with a cleaning cloth, rinse with water and dry off with a squeegee or cloth. Avoid scratching the surface. Do not use strong alkaline or abrasive cleaning agents. Alkaline cleaning agents could leave a pale film on the surface over time.

Felt surfaces

Vacuum gently using the textile nozzle or wash lightly with water. If you need cleaning agent, choose agents designed for use on wool, as the felt is 90% wool. Alternatively, shampoo can be used, but test first on a small area that is not in obvious or direct view. Excess liquids should be absorbed using household paper. Stains should be soaked, not scoured. When removing a stain, work on the stained area and outwards so that a ring will not appear on the felt. Water and cleaning agent should be used sparingly. Stains should be removed immediately, so that they don't seep into the felt. Solid dirt should be removed by careful scarping.

Laminate surfaces metallic parts

Wipe the surfaces with a damp cleaning cloth. If needed, use a mild general cleaning agent. Finish off with a microfiber cloth if needed. Do not leave the surface wet. Do not let electrical appliances or sockets come into contact with water.

Carpet

Vacuum the carpet using the carpet nozzle. If the dirt has seeped in, wash with water and textile cleaning agent. Rinse with water and dry off. Test the cleaning agent on an area that is least noticeable first to test the suitability on the material. Vacuum the rail of the sliding door when vacuuming the carpet. Slide the door so that the whole rail can be reached.
